WHAT IS THE CAREER ADVANCEMENT PROGRAMME?

The Career Advancement Programme (CAP) is a service that is offered by the Ministry of Education (MoE). The programme provides youth (16-18 years) with access to free education and training that will help them to get a career.

The CAP General programme is integrated into the High School Diploma Equivalency (HSDE) programme of the JFLL. Its primary objectives are:

- To create access to education.
- To establish pathways that will take a learner from where they are to where they want to go.
- To provide the learner with an opportunity to improve himself in a caring environment.

GOALS OF THE CAP - GENERAL

- To acquire functional literacy and numeracy skills.
- To prepare individuals for further academic and career studies.
- To prepare individuals for the World of Work.

LEARNER PROFILING:

A profile will be developed for each learner to enable teachers to focus on the learner's individual needs.

DURATION OF PROGRAMME

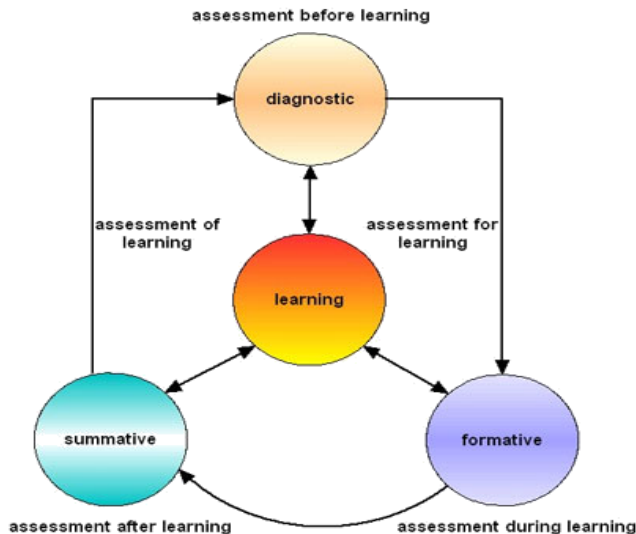
The CAP General Programme is a two (2) years programme. Training begins with each academic school year, however a learner may be permitted to enrol at other periods during the year provided space is available. Each level of the programme will last for one year.

A learner who starts at the basic level is expected to complete the programme in two years. However, there is flexibility that allows a learner to advance through the programme at a faster pace depending on performance. The learner will be placed at the appropriate level based on their profile.

CORE SUBJECTS COVERED AT THE BASIC AND INTERMEDIATE LEVELS ARE:

- Mathematics
- Language
- Skills Training
- Life /Employability Skills
